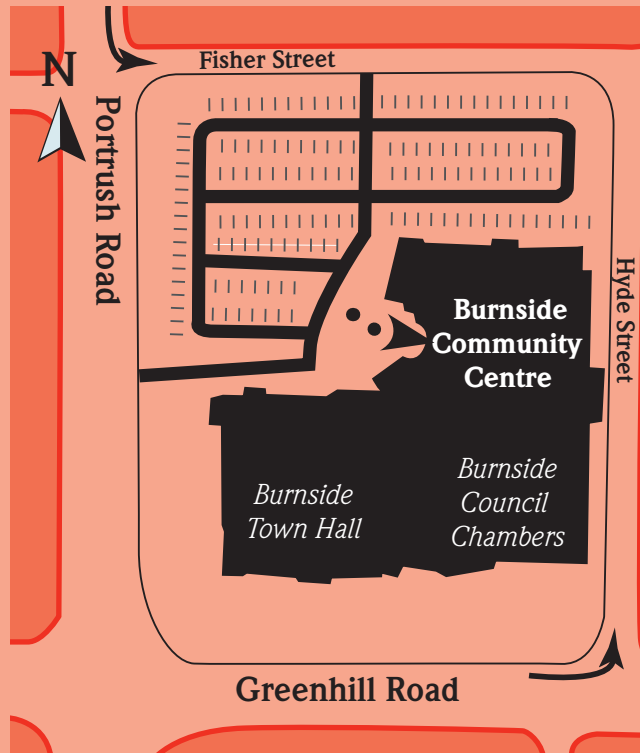

An analysis of the works of an early colonial artist

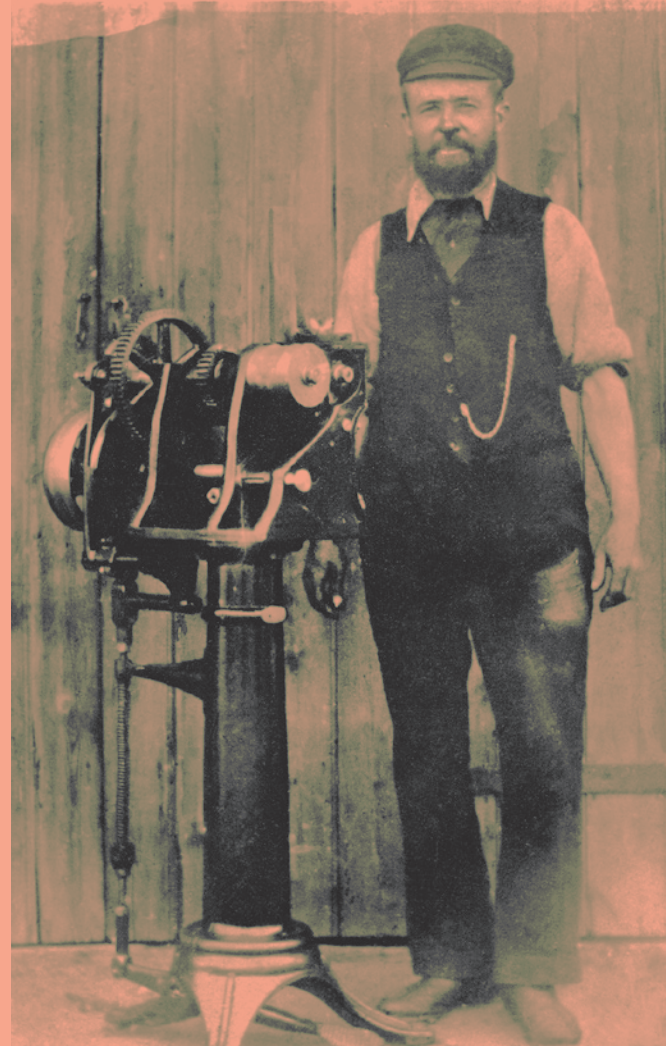
